He holds the Dina and Eli Field Family Chair in Jewish History at The Jewish Theological Seminary and teaches courses in medieval and early modern Jewish history, with a special focus on medieval Sephardim. He lectures widely on the entire range of Jewish history.

An energetic scholar and teacher, Dr. Gampel is dedicated to bringing the history of the Jews to a broad public audience. He has addressed synagogues and lay groups, organizations of all stripes, and scholarly conclaves, and has been featured on television.

Dr. Gampel was very enthusiastically received as our featured SYNERGY guest last winter. This year he will discuss three new topics, on Friday evening, Saturday following Kiddush, and on Sunday morning with religious school sixth graders and their parents.
